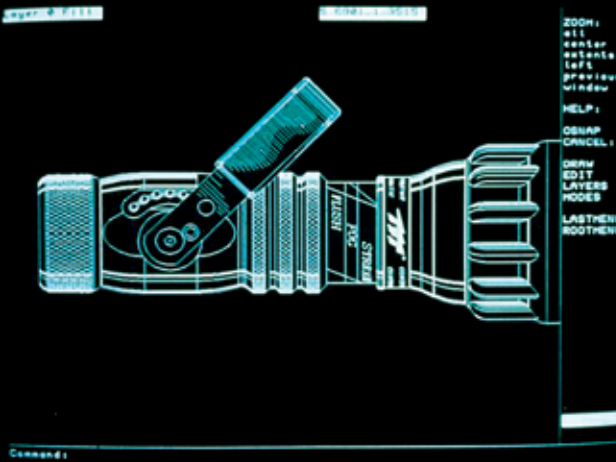
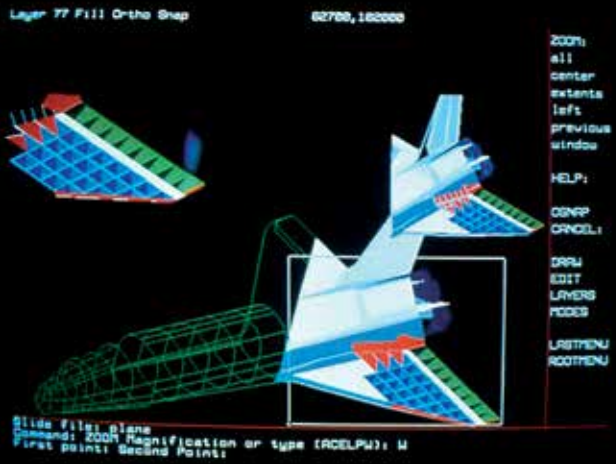
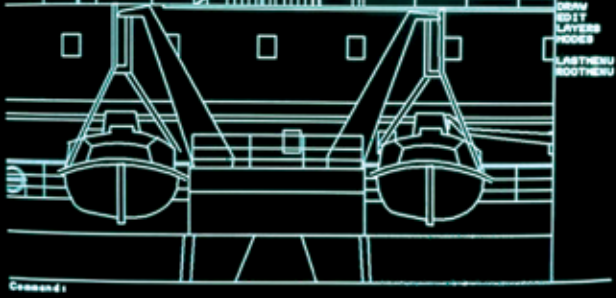

Here, for example, you can see the staff of the Autodesk Moscow office using them as lenses to safely view a solar eclipse in 2015.

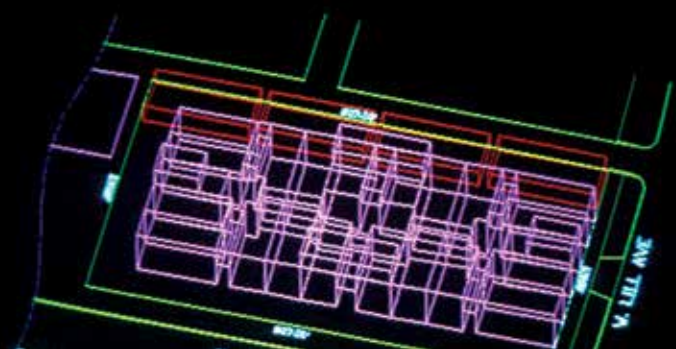




AutoCAD Rocks
